Follow the A590 into Ulverston, then turn left onto the A5087 Coast Road. After 7 miles, before the village of Newbiggin, turn left down an unmarked road next to a large white house called 'Seed Hall'. After 100 metres you will reach the park.

New fully serviced pitches for caravan holiday homes with piped metered gas supply are now available.

Seacroft is open from the 1st March until the 15th January. The fees for 2011 are £1578, including VAT and rates.
